## Using Photographs in the Classroom

### Learning Outcome

To learn how to use photographs for a range of different educational aims, including for topics that are familiar and those that may be quite unfamiliar

To investigate the uses of different types of photographs, and the choice of information provided with them (explanation, captions, background etc).

To look at sources of photographs, and how to use



### Event Process

Participants explore the use of photos and the power of photos through looking at a range of photos taken across the world and reflecting many different themes. They experience photographs with different sets of information to explore how we contextualise photos with children.

Participants take part in a carousel of activities that use photographs, taken from '51 Things to do with a photo' - a resource that teachers take away. These activities can be reworked and adapted for their own needs and according to fresh ideas they have.

Participants choose an educational aim (e.g. stimulating research, enhancing critical thinking, developing empathy and challenging stereotypes) and use advice on how to create an activity for a chosen educational aims, including guidance questions, to come up with an idea for lesson using a photo.
